

## Canada Online Academy Academic/ESL Policy

The academic success of every student in Canada Online Academy (COA) is important to us. For international students whose first language is not English, COA would recommend courses that best match their English proficiency level according to the entrance examination result.

To better help students understand course content and achieve academic success, a minimum of English as a Second Language proficiency level 5 (ESLEO) is highly recommended to enroll in any Grade 11 or 12 courses. Students with language proficiency of ESLCO and above are eligible to take courses in Grade 10 and above. If any student with language proficiency of ESLDO and below is interested in taking any senior grade (Grade 11 & 12) course, it is the student's responsibility to face any possible academic consequences including undesirable outcome. Students should know that all unsuccessful Grade 11 or 12 courses will be recorded on the Ontario Student Transcript.

If any student with language proficiency level of ESLDO and below still decide to choose senior grade courses, please follow the procedure below:
